Nick McMahon Neighbourhood Liaison Officer for the East End	There are real problems in the residential areas north and (especially) south of Embankment Road, that are often reported at neighbourhood meetings - in particular the lack of available on street parking for residents particularly during the day time, also some residents' reports of long term parking of vehicles from outside the area, and reports of congestion issues caused by parking on corners or in locations making it difficult for larger vehicles to manoeuvre. There are no alternative places for residents to park. There is a popular view that the area is used as a free car park for City commuters. That said, we have also heard two views as to whether CPZs would be favoured, this would need to be tested by a proper survey
