
















































### Narrowing the Gap - An alternative view


Many of the current indicators relating to the 'narrowing the gap' agenda focus entirely on the outcomes of young people with a particularly attribute with no regard to their prior attainment.

National indicator (NI) 102b measures the attainment gap (G) at KS4 between those entitled to Free School Meals (FSM) and those not entitled.


Recent values of this indicator for Plymouth have shown some volatility and are somewhat counter intuitive.



If, however, the cohort considered is one based on a starting point where it is reasonable to expect 5A\*to C (EM) then the picture is very different. The following shows the attainment gap as above but for a KS4 cohort with an APS of 27 (fine grade) points or more at KS2.



A similar pattern emerges if the gap relates to IDACI values above and below 0.4






