Further to your correspondence concerning the above I wish to advise you that I will be represented by Councillor John Lock at the licensing sub-committee sitting on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2010. He will raise the following points on my behalf:-

- 1. The proximity of the premises to St Mary's Park where under-age drinking has been a problem in the past.
- 2. The use of St. Mary's Church as a playground and rubbish tip likewise St. Mary's Infants School close by.
- 3. The previous problems encountered at the Tesco Express in Glen Road where gangs of young people congregated and harassed local residents as well as those wishing to use the shop.
- 4. The increase in traffic to an already busy junction and access to the public car park attached to St. Mary's Playing Fields which is being advertised by Tesco as a "free parking" facility.
- 5. Management of deliveries to the store with infants, junior and nursery schools within yards of the property as well as the main route for children going to the two senior schools in the area, it is hoped that their deliveries will be timed not to coincide with the start and end of the school day.
- 6. The manner in which the store displayed the licensing application notice made it very difficult if not impossible for the public to see it and thus object/comment upon.
- Request that the licensing sub-committee limit the hours that alcohol is served at the premises to 10.00 - 20.00 if not seven days a week at least on Fridays and Saturdays when problems are more likely to occur in the park and surrounding areas.
