The principles of the allocation of seats to political groups

Section 15 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 and the Local Government (Committees and Political Groups) Regulations, the City Council has a duty to review the representation of different political groups at its Annual Meeting in respect of bodies to which the section applies. Section 15 provides that, in performing this duty, the council has a duty to make only such determinations as give effect so far as reasonably practicable to the following principles:

- (a) that not all the seats on committees are allocated to the same political group;
- (b) that the majority of the seats on each committee are allocated to a particular political group if the number of persons belonging to that group are a majority of the authority's membership;
- (c) subject to (a) and (b), that the number of seats on committees which are allocated to each group bears the same proportion to the total of all the seats on committees of the council as is borne by the number of members of that group to the membership of the authority, and
- (d) Subject to (a) to (c) above, that the number of seats on each committee which are allocated to each political group bears the same proportion to the number of all the seats on that committee as is borne by the number of members of that group to the membership of the authority.

The application of those principles is set out below

Principle (a) – The seats will be allocated amongst the Labour and Conservative groups

Principle (b) – As the majority group, the Labour group will receive the majority of seats on each committee

Principle (c) The allocation of seats on all committees is based on the group's percentage of total Council membership is as set out below

Executive Summary:

The Council is being recommended to appoint an interim Chief Executive pending an appointment to the role on a permanent basis. Following the appointment of the interim Chief Executive, it is recommended that they be designated as head of paid service. It is also recommended that the Monitoring Officer is delegated the statutory roles relating to electoral registration, elections and referenda.

Recommendations & Reasons for recommended action:

- 1. To approve the appointment of Bob Coomber as interim Chief Executive with effect from 24 May 2012, pending an appointment to the role on a permanent basis through the recruitment and selection process which is already underway.
- 2. To delegate to the Director for Corporate Services authority to agree the terms for the engagement of the interim Chief Executive in consultation with the Council Leader.
- 3. To approve that the interim Chief Executive is designated as the head of paid service in accordance with the Local Government and Housing Act 1989 for the duration of the interim arrangement.

The reason for the recommendation is that the Council is legally required to designate one of its officers as the head of paid service and the role is generally undertaken by the chief executive.

4. To appoint the Monitoring Officer as the electoral registration officer and returning officer under the Representation of the People Act 1983.

The reason for the recommendation is that the Council is required to appoint to these roles to manage the electoral registration and elections functions. In particular preparatory work needs to be undertaken for the election of the Police and Crime Commissioner.

Alternative options considered and reasons for recommended action:

For practical purposes, it is appropriate that the chief executive is also the head of paid service.

The Monitoring Officer is presently responsible for the electoral registration and election functions and is the Council's deputy returning officer and has undertaken the role of returning officer and electoral registration officer at Plymouth and previous local authorities.
