 Licencing Office and a warning letter would be issued;
- 2. The driver's Hackney Carriage Driver's Licence would be suspended for 30 days under s19 (1) Plymouth City Council Act 1975 for 'any reasonable cause' and a warning letter would be issued.

Driver's Licence.
