Executive Summary:

We have received an application from an employee of the Council requesting permission to remove a Sycamore tree that has significant decay at the base and to trim back another Sycamore tree by 1.5-2m from the side of the house. Both trees form part of a group protected by Tree Preservation Order no. 228 Whitleigh Lodge, Budshead, Plymouth.

Corporate Plan 2011-2014:

Protecting trees enhances the quality of the City's environment by ensuring long-term tree cover. Trees help to reduce pollution and traffic noise providing cleaner air to breathe thereby helping to achieve the Council's corporate goal to create a healthy place to live and work and accords with its objective to improve health and wellbeing, as well as creating a more attractive environment. <u>http://www.plymouth.gov.uk/corporateplan.htm</u>

Dealing with applications for works to protected trees is a routine exercise for the local planning authority. There are no additional financial costs arising from the processing of these applications that are not included in existing budgets.

Recommendations & Reasons for recommended action:

To give consent for the works and to require a condition to replace the tree with a suitable species in the next available planting season.

Reason: the decayed tree needs to be made safe. The loss of an adjacent Sycamore in the recent storms has meant its shelter has been lost and this tree with a decayed stem may be prone to wind throw. The trimming back from the side of the house is sensible management to prevent future damage to the building.

Alternative options considered and reasons for recommended action:

To refuse consent: the structural condition of the tree at the base that the applicant has applied to fell is poor – to refuse consent for its removal would be inappropriate. The trimming of the other Sycamore is necessary to prevent interference with the side of the house, no other option is available.



Background Report

I. Introduction

- 1.1 Under delegated authority on the 20th December 1990, Tree Preservation Order No.228 was made to protect various trees at Whitleigh Lodge, Budshead, Plymouth.
- 1.2 An application has been received from an employee of the council to carry out works to two trees protected by the above order and under our delegated procedures any such application is required to be reported to the Planning Committee.





2. Assessment of Application

The owner has applied for the following work:-

2.1 T1 – Sycamore – fell

This tree has a large area of decay at the base (see photo below). An adjacent tree was recently lost in the storms (T2) on plan and this tree is now exposed and may be prone to wind throw. It is therefore considered that the application to fell the tree should be approved on safety grounds. A condition to replace the tree with a suitable species in the next available planting season will be applied.



2.2 T2 – Sycamore

This tree was blown down in the recent gales.

2.3 T3 – Sycamore adjacent to side of house Trim back growth closest to house by 1.5 -2m. This work is required to prevent interference with the roof and side of the house.

3. Conclusion

3.1 In view of the above assessment it is considered that the application should be granted consent.

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This application has been referred to Planning Committee by Councillor Sue McDonald.

Site Description

The application proposes an ATM which is to be located within the shopfront of the Oriental Supermarket. The site is located within The Parade on the Barbican.

Proposal Description

The application proposes the installation of an ATM with an illuminated fascia.

Pre-Application Enquiry

None.

Relevant Planning History

None.

Consultation Responses

The Police Architectural Liaison Officer raised a number of issues with the proposed ATM including limited natural surveillance in the area, as well as poor lighting which combined could make it vulnerable for persons using the machine, and easy for criminals to illegally tamper with the ATM. The Police Architectural Liaison Officer suggested that these concerns could be overcome by conditions which require the applicant to install and maintain adequate CCTV and lighting in the area. Highways Authority - No objections (verbal response)

Representations

One representation was received from resident which objects to the proposal on the grounds of the potential for the proposal to contribute towards unacceptable noise, illegal parking and anti-social behaviour.

Analysis

- 1. The National Planning Policy Framework seeks to actively encourage and promote sustainable forms of development. It replaces all previous Planning Policy guidance issued at National Government Level.
- 2. This application has been considered in the context of the Council's adopted planning policy in the form of the Local Development Framework-Core Strategy 2007 and is considered to be compliant with National Planning Policy Framework guidance.
- 3. The application turns upon policies CS02 (Design), Policy CS32 (Designing out crime), CS28 (Local Transport Considerations) and CS34 (Planning application considerations) of the Adopted Core Strategy of Plymouth's Local Development Framework 2006-2021 and the aims of the Council's Development Guidelines Supplementary Planning Document (2010), and the National Planning Policy Framework. The key considerations are the visual impact of the ATM machine on the character and appearance of the area, the impact to residential amenity and the safety of users and pedestrians.

Impact on the character and appearance of the area

4. The site fronts onto one of the main traffic routes into the Barbican and is located within the Barbican Conservation Area. The application proposes an ATM fascia with a black bezel surround and white illuminated lettering. Following discussions with the agent, officers have secured amendments to the previous design which included blue halo illumination which was proposed on all sides of the ATM. This blue halo illumination was considered to be detrimental to the character and appearance of the conservation area. As amendments have been agreed and the drawings amended to exclude the blue halo illumination, the proposed design is now considered to be appropriate and compliant with Policy CS02 (Design) and Policy CS03 (Historic Environment).

Residential Amenity

- 5. The location upon which the ATM is proposed falls within the Barbican Local Centre as identified in Diagram 5 (Spatial Distribution of Shopping Provision) of the adopted Core Strategy. Local centres play a vital role and are not only places to shop, but provide a wide variety of services for communities. Objections have been raised by a resident relating to the potential for the proposal to cause noise and disruption to nearby residents. While these objections have been taken into account, it is the opinion of officers that the noise and disruption caused by the ATM is unlikely to be unreasonable in the proposed location given its role as a local centre and is therefore considered to be compliant with Policy CS34 of the Core Strategy.
- 6. Consideration has also been given to whether the ATM would have any unreasonable impact on the highway. Following consultation with the Highways Authority, officers were advised that any impact would be minimal, as the majority of visitors to this area of the Barbican tend to be pedestrians, and as such the proposal is considered to be compliant with Policy CS28 of the Core Strategy.

Public Safety

7. The Police Architectural Liaison Officer has raised a number of concerns related to the potential for crime and/or anti-social behaviour due to the limited natural surveillance at the site location. This is primarily due to the fact that the ATM would be opposite a blank elevation of a residential block. Lighting was also identified as a potential issue which could further give rise to the potential for crime or anti-social behaviour. To deal with the issues of reduced natural surveillance and lighting in the area, planning conditions have been recommended which require the installation of CCTV and lighting which should be maintained in full working order and operational throughout the use of the ATM. On this basis, the proposal is considered to be acceptable and does not conflict with the Core Strategy Policy CS32 (Designing out crime).

Human Rights

Human Rights Act - The development has been assessed against the provisions of the Human Rights Act, and in particular Article I of the First Protocol and Article 8 of the Act itself. This Act gives further effect to the rights included in the European Convention on Human Rights. In arriving at this recommendation, due regard has been given to the applicant's reasonable development rights and expectations which have been balanced and weighed against the wider community interests, as expressed through third party interests / the Development Plan and Central Government Guidance.

Local Finance Considerations

Under the present Community Infrastructure Levy charging schedule no CIL contribution is required for this development.

Conclusions

It is recommended that this planning application is **granted conditionally** for the reasons set out in this report.
