53. **APPOINTMENT OF VICE CHAIR**

The committee agreed to appoint Councillor Mrs Nicholson as Vice Chair for this particular meeting.

54. **DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

63. **REVIEW OF A HACKNEY CARRIAGE DRIVER'S LICENCE - BC (E3 AND E7)**

The committee

- (a) considered the report from the Director of Public Health;
- (b) heard from BC and his representative;
- (c) took the above report and all that was said by BC into consideration.

The committee agreed that–

- (1) having taken the above into account BC is required to resit his driving test;
- (2) BC's hackney carriage driver's licence is suspended for five days under Section 19(1)(b) of the Plymouth City Council Act 1975;
- (3) BC is required to obtain the Level 2 VRQ in Transporting Passengers by Taxi and Private Hire or equivalent within the next 12 months.

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
