The medical certificate will also be required because it is over twelve months since one was last produced.

# 24. APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT OF A PRIVATE HIRE DRIVER'S LICENCE - JPB

The committee <u>agreed</u> that having taken the above into account to grant JPB's application for a private hire driver's licence. He will also be required to complete the VRQ driver qualification in Transporting Passengers by Taxi and Private Hire or its equivalent within the first 12 months of receiving his licence.
