64. Plymouth and South West Devon Joint Local Plan

Councillor Nicholson (Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Strategic Transport, Housing and Planning) proposed and Councillor Bowyer (Leader) seconded the Plymouth and South West Devon Joint Local Plan (Cabinet minute 69 refers).

Following a vote, Council agreed -

- that the Plymouth and South West Devon Local Plan be formally approved and subject to a six-week period for representations to be received, pursuant to Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations, subject to changes outlined in the table below.
- 2. that following the completion of the six-week period for representations the local plan be formally submitted for Public Examination.
- that delegated authority to agree minor amendments to the Plymouth and South West Devon Joint Local Plan prior to its submission be given to the Assistant Director for Strategic Planning and Infrastructure, in consultation with the Joint Local Plan Member Steering Group.

4. that the Plymouth and South West Devon Joint Local Plan Steering Group continue to oversee the Joint Local Plan to ensure its effective monitoring and review, and that officers be instructed to draw up a revised Collaboration Agreement to this effect between West Devon Borough Council, South Hams District Council and Plymouth City Council, with responsibility delegated to the Assistant Director of Strategic Planning and Infrastructure for signing the Collaboration Agreement, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Strategic Housing, Transport, and Planning.

65. Plymouth Plan Refresh

Councillor Nicholson (Deputy Leader and Cabinet Member for Strategic Transport, Housing and Planning) proposed and Councillor Bowyer (Leader) seconded the Plymouth Plan Refresh (Cabinet minute 70 refers).

Following a vote, Council agreed -

- That the updates set out in the report to Modules 2 (Philosophy), 3 (Vision), 5 (Healthy City), 6 (Growing City) and 7 (International City) of the Plymouth Plan Part One be approved.
- 2. That subject to formal adoption of the Plymouth and South West Devon Local Plan, the Plymouth specific policies be combined with the Plymouth Plan refresh to recreate a single integrated web based document, with delegated authority to the Assistant Direction for Strategic Planning and Infrastructure, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Strategic Housing, Transport, and Planning, to publish this on the Plymouth Plan website.
