6. Market Factor Supplement for the Post of an Assistant Director

Carole Burgoyne (Strategic Director for People) provided a brief overview of the market factor supplement for the post of an Assistant Director report.

Following discussions, officers were requested to advise the panel at its next meeting concerning a review of the Pay Policy.

The Panel agreed to -

- (1) approve a variation to the market factor supplement for the Assistant Director for Children, Young People and Families totalling £17,010 per annum (including on costs) for duration of 12 months from 1 October 2017; this sum will be subject to income tax and national insurance deductions; this represents an increase of £6,854 per annum on the current arrangement;
- (2) approve the backdating of the variation from I April 2017.
