Councillor Mrs Beer advised Members that as the Cabinet Members who also had responsibility in their portfolios for items under consideration at this meeting, were not present they would be represented by the Leader.

### 38. **Declarations of Interest**

### 39. Minutes

### 42. Senior Management Pay and Reward Review

# 43. People Directorate Senior Management Update

The Panel -

- (2) noted the work being undertaken to confirm there are no issues arising in respect of the Director of Children's Services Local Assurance Test.
