Purpose of Review

In response to the electoral registration issues that arose during preparations for the UK Parliamentary General Election in December 2019, Tracey Lee, Plymouth's Electoral Registration Officer (ERO) commissioned an independent internal review of the various data sets, to be led by Andy Ralphs, Strategic Director for Customer and Corporate Services to:

- ascertain where the issues were
- make sure issues were rectified
- ensure any affected customers were notified and where required informed of any actions they would need to take
- ensure lessons were learned and recommendations made to ensure the integrity of the register for future elections.

As part of the lessons learned the ERO asked the Chair of Scrutiny Management Board, Councillor Mrs Aspinall, to review the issues, actions and lessons learned through a cross-party select committee.
