## 49. CHAIR'S URGENT BUSINESS

### **Whitleigh School Campus**

The Chair advised that, following advice at the last Planning Committee that all spoil material from the new access would be retained on site, the applicants had now advised that 75% would be moved off site. It was proposed that this issue would be covered by way of the Code of Construction Condition.

All Members expressed their concern that the applicants had changed the advice on this and insisted in very strong terms that the Code of Construction Condition should include the following requirements to avoid complaints –

- (i) no traffic to use Lancaster Gardens;
- (ii) all vehicles to be cleaned (wheel washes) prior to leaving the site;
- (iii) all vehicles to be sheeted;
- (iv) regular inspection of compliance and enforcement where breached.

Resolved that the Code of Construction Condition be applied, to include (i) to (iv) above.

(Councillor Nicholson declared a prejudicial interest in respect of the above item and withdrew from the meeting.)
