## **Purpose of Report**

This report has been provided as a supplementary paper for cabinet consideration in conjunction with the Completed Pledges Report (RefP2020/Mar20). This report gives details of a further two pledges; 54 and 89 that have now been completed in addition to pledges 9, 15, 31, 33, 42, 86, 90 and 91. This now brings the total number of pledges completed to 73 out of the 100 pledges made over a four year period from 2018 to 2022.

A "pledge on a page" overview has been prepared for each pledge:

- Pledge 54: We will work with the NHS, the third sector and pharmacists to create a
  network of health and well-being centres across the city to make good health advice
  available across Plymouth to deliver good health in your high street.
- Pledge 89: Live music venues are an important part of our city's cultural offer to residents and visitors. We will support the Agent of Change campaign to support the city's existing live music venues when new housing developments take place alongside them.
