6	Alternative options considered and rejected:
	Do nothing: This is not an option. COVID-19 poses a risk to public health and a resilience mortuary is urgently required to respond to this emergency.
	Run a competitive procurement process: This is not an option. The time limits for the open, restricted procedures or competitive procedures with negotiation cannot be complied with. There is also no time to undertake a standard procedure with accelerated timescales due to urgency.

When the annual budget for this year was agreed, we were unaware of the financial implications of dealing with the response to Covid 19 for the Council.
