	It is recommended that the Leader of the Council:							
	Approves the introduction of two additional elements into the Mayflower 400 Capital budget which are monument lighting ( $\pounds 120,000$ ) and memorial interpretation ( $\pounds 15,000$ ) funded from the existing trails/monument/public realm capital allocation.							
	Approve the virement of £776,296 from the trails/monument/public realm capital allocation trails to the Elizabethan House project.							
5	Reasons for decision:							
	To allow the funding to be directed where it is most needed to meet the programme objectives.							
6	Alternative options considered and rejected:							
	Do nothing and keep to the original cost plan set out in the December 2018 decision – This would not allow the key programme priorities to be met and spend to be directed where it is most needed.							
7	Financial implications:							
	There are no additional capital requirements as a result of this decision. Adding into the programme the monument lighting and memorial interpretation will reduce budget pressures on the capital programme.
