5	Reasons for decision: Following the retirement of Judith Harwood (former Service Director for Education, Partnership & Skills) and Andrew Hardingham (former Service Director for Finance), there is a need to appoint replacement directors to fill the vacant positions. The council may appoint two directors the Board according to the Catered's Articles of Association. As such, it is recommended that the officers named in the above section are appointed as directors of Catered.
