	<ul> <li>The Leader of the Council is asked to:</li> <li>approve that the Council enters a Co-operation Agreement with Homes England in relation to land at Woolwell; and</li> <li>delegate authority to the Strategic Director for Place to agree and sign the Co-operation Agreement (subject to due diligence) and any other related contracts or agreements, including but not limited to any Section 106 Agreement, collaboration agreement with other land owners, wayleaves or easements related to the site and any future Promotion Agreement for the site.</li> </ul>
5	Reasons for decision:  To progress the delivery of high quality homes on a site allocated in the Joint Local Plan, to explore the potential to attract third party investment in infrastructure and to generate a capital receipt for the Council.
6	Alternative options considered and rejected:  The Council could negotiate with adjacent land owners directly. However, Homes England has extensive experience of large scale, complex land assembly and may be able to secure additional investment in infrastructure.
