	Accept the funding offer of up to 1,127,995 Euros from the Interreg V A France (Channel) England 2014- 2020 programme by way of a signed funding agreement							
5	Reasons for decision:							
	PCC has secured funding from the Interreg V A France (Channel) England 2014-2020 programme to increase the quality and effectiveness of service delivery to the most socially and economically disadvantaged groups through social innovation.							
	The project will deliver 4 cross-border work packages aimed at supporting individuals at risk of exclusion and businesses at risk of closure in order to reverse some of the negative impacts of the pandemic.							
	This focus on several interrelated topic areas and the associated activities will play a key role in reducing business closures, reducing the risk of individuals becoming socially and economically excluded and ensuring a sustainable recovery across the FCE area.

	(I) Do Nothing							
	The sudden impact of Covid 19 meant that authorities first had to react and respond. There has been little time as yet to reflect on the effectiveness of this response on a local, regional or national basis let alone to look beyond national boundaries.							
	Doing nothing and failing to consider looking at Cross-border solutions we will lose the opportunity to examine different responses in different national, regional and local contexts and learn the lessons and best practice from what is being done in a range of locations. There would be no added value to own
