- 4 Decision to be taken:
 - To implement amendments to The City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2007 (as amended).
 - The effect of the order shall be to change the tariffs at both Napier Terrace Car Park and Mutley Barracks Car Park to 'Up to 3 hours free', 'Over 3 hours £5' and '£50 per month'.
- 5 Reasons for decision:

This decision will provide additional support to local businesses and support aspirations to improve trading conditions for businesses as is aligned to wider Council commitments to maintain free parking within district car parks.

6 Alternative options considered and rejected:

The alternative option of not implementing this decision is rejected as this would not provide additional support to local businesses or support aspirations to improve trading conditions. This decision has also been defined as a priority commitment for the Council.

7 Financial implications:

There is a cost of £2k to implement this decision relating to the publication of public notices, car park signage and reconfiguration of parking payment systems. This is to be funded from the Off Street Parking Trading Account.

It is not possible to accurate determine the financial implications of this decision as it is not possible to predetermine customer behaviour; however this decision is expected to have an adverse implication on parking income to the Off Street Parking Trading Account of £55k in 21/22 and £83k from 22/23, based on levels of income in 19/20 (pre COVID19 levels of income)
