	 Accepts supplementary grant offer of £240,000 from the Heart of the South West Local Enterprise Partnership Getting Building Fund.
	 Allocates £240,000 for the project into the capital programme funded by South West Local Enterprise Partnership Getting Building Fund.
	 Delegates the signing of the grant funding agreement to the Service Director for Economic Development.

	To increase the value of the capital programme for the project in order to meet the required costs to deliver these schemes effectively.
