5 Reasons for decision:

Statutory and voluntary sector partners have been discussing the need for a short term care centre in Plymouth for a number of years, to support discharge from hospital, promote independence, to reduce reliance on long-term residential care and large long-term packages of domiciliary care. The Covid-19 pandemic has exacerbated the need to improve hospital discharge pathways which enable people to return to health in a supported therapeutic environment.

The Centre will offer Step Down and Step Up, mainly for older people in Plymouth who are ready for discharge from hospital, but not yet well enough to return home. Therapy and other support services will be provided for focussed interventions to speed up the rehabilitation process so that patients can be quickly and confidently discharged home.

The care centre will provide 24 beds and associated communal areas including staff office accommodation. The use of this centre will reduce the pressure within the system and the costs of using private sector care.
