5	Reasons for decision:							
	Funding from central government for the Household Support Grant was confirmed on the 6 th October to support vulnerable households during the winter months including with food, energy and other essentials costs. The attached plan describes the proposals for the use of this fund to target people at risk of fuel and financial insecurity, based on the learning from similar grant funding received last winter. This plan needs to be returned to the DWP by October 29 th .

	This is not an option as the Council has been awarded grant funding to support vulnerable households, with at least 50% of the funding targeted on households with children and young people. To not use or accept this funding would be to the detriment of Plymouth people.
