4	Decision to be taken: To implement amendments to The City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2007 (as amended). The effect of the order shall be to establish a tariff for Pay & Display within the car park, which allows for free parking for Three hours, with no return for two hours.						
5	Reasons for decision: This decision will provide the opportunity for visitors and local residents the opportunity to visit the Devils Point Area and use the free car park which is often full with worker vehicles from near by businesses, this impacting on tourism and access to the area.						
6	Alternative options considered and rejected:						
	The alternative option of not implementing this decision is rejected as this would not provide additional support to local residents of businesses or support aspirations to improve conditions and access to the area.						

7 Financial implications and risks:

There is a cost of £5.5k to implement this decision relating to the publication of public notices, car park signage and installation and configuration of parking payment systems. This is to be funded from the Off Street Parking Trading Account.

It is not possible to accurate determine the financial implications of this decision as it is not possible to predetermine customer behaviour; however this decision is expected to have a positive impact through enforcement of the time restrictions
