  - Single vs multiple branch GP practices;
  - Skills mix across GP practices;
  - GP Appointment capacity and demand for appointments across GP practices including DNA rates.
- the impact of the General Practice 5 year forward view (2016)
- the existing and future workforce and demographic pressures which may impact on current and future access to GP services.
- the role of GP Practices, Primary Care Networks in the developing Integrated Care System
- areas of good practice (both national and international) in relation to
  - o workforce pressures and skill mix.
  - o delivery of primary care in urban (and rural areas)
  - o recruitment and retention at start and end of career.
  - o access, quality and resilience.
  - additional services to support primary care.
- the local authorities' role and responsibilities in supporting GP services at a place and neighbourhood level.
