The proposed order and associated works on-site were required by the Planning Committee at the time of consent for the new food store. Alternative options considered and rejected: 6 None – the requirement for the installation of bollards and prohibition of driving along Torbridge Road except for access was a requirement from the Planning Committee as part of the determination of planning consent for the Aldi store development on Galileo Close.

7 Financial implications and risks:

The Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and associated works is being funded via Planning with funding secured from the developer via a \$106 Agreement.
