4	Decision to be taken: To approve the service area policies and updated charges (as appended) for discretionary fees. For implementation on or after 1st March 2022, as is practical.							
5	Reasons for decision: Discretionary fees and charges have not been consistently uplifted to reflect rising costs using CPI, due to COVID-19.							
6	Alternative options considered and rejected: The alternative option is to not bring fees and charges in line with rising costs. This has been rejected as failure to implement an increase in discretionary fees and charges will require alternative savings to be developed and agreed.							
7	Financial implications and Risks: By making this decision, discretionary services provided will cover full costs with the exception of where the cost will make accessing services for vulnerable members of the community cost prohibitive. This work has been prepared in conjunction with the Medium Term Financial Strategy and associated delivery plans and therefore contributes to the overall objective of achieving a balanced budget.
