| Question: now the pandemic is over can you please confirm when Devonport library will reopen to normal hours instead of just two days a week.  |                  |
| Answer:<br><br>The Library Service has recently extended opening hours at Devonport. The library now opens from 9am to 5pm on Mondays and Wednesdays, rather than from 11am to 5pm, thus increasing total hours open each week from 12 to 16. This adjustment enables local churches to run the social café from the library meeting room on Wednesday mornings.<br><br>The Library Service reviews its opening schedule on a regular basis, and will continue to open the maximum days and hours according to staffing resources available. |                  |
