5	Reasons for decision: As part of the planning permission (ref 07/01094/OUT) granted to Persimmon Homes for the development of Saltram Meadow it was agreed that traffic mitigation measures would need to be put in place at Marsh Mills Roundabout for the extra traffic the site would attract. This was also a requirement for the site by National Highways and it was agreed that it would be done with Section 106 funding and that Plymouth City Council would carry ou works to enable MOVA traffic signal operation at the roundabout.
6	Alternative options considered and rejected: If the works aren't carried out the Saltram Meadow development will have to stop and this will reflect badly on Plymouth City Council for not carrying out our own requirements as laid down in the planning permission.
7	Financial implications and risks:
	The Section S106 funding has been received from the Saltram Meadow development. This funding has been specifically secured from the developer for this purpose. There is no other Plymouth City Council funding required for this project.
