To implement the following amendments to The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004.

The effect of the order shall be to;

I. Add/Amend Urban Clearway at Any Time on lengths of the following roads: Delamere Road, Embankment Lane, Embankment Road, Gdynia Way, Laira Bridge Road, Leigham Roundabout, Longbridge Road, Marsh Mills Roundabout, Old Laira Road, Plymouth Road, Slip Roads between Leigham Roundabout & Marsh Mills Roundabout.

5 Reasons for decision:

The existing Clearway Orders on the main routes into the City are out of date, often due to road improvements since the Orders were introduced. The Clearway Orders enable both Police and Plymouth City Council to undertake enforcement against vehicles parked or left abandoned on major routes where the introduction of other parking restrictions would not be appropriate.

6 Alternative options considered and rejected:

The alternative option would be to do nothing. This option was discounted on the basis that the changes are needed for enforcement to ensure safety of the public.

7 Financial implications and risks:

The Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) and associated works is being funded via the Traffic Management Team and will be paid out of their budget.
