4	Decision to be taken: Approval to submit application to DEFRA for the designation of Firestone Bay as an Official Bathing Water							
5	Reasons for decision: Popularity of wild swimming and water based recreational activity has increased around Firestone Bay in last few years, and especially since Covid pandemic.							
	Designation of Firestone Bay as an official Bathing Water would ensure monitoring and testing of water quality by the Environment Agency between May and September each year. The data would be made publically available.							
	Plymouth already has 2 designated Bathing Waters at Plymouth Hoe East and Plymouth Hoe West. The designation of a 3 rd Bathing Water within the city would be beneficial to all residents and visitors, and recognised as part of the National Marine Park.

	(Option 1) Do not submit application — rejected because proposal has cross party support. All evidence required for the application has been successfully collated and application prepared. DEFRA aware of pending application and are keen to receive for this year.
