	Plymouth City Council, along with its partners the University of Plymouth, have been successful in the award of funding to support research into tackling health inequalities.								
	This offers an opportunity for Plymouth (both the Council and wider partners) to further our understanding of understanding what can be done to prevent people from dying earlier than they should and leading more of their lives in poor health, through considering the places and circumstances that people lead their lives.								
	The Council is not able to release full details at this present time due to a restriction on publication. A decision is required however to ensure that the Council is in a position to sign the agreements required by NIHR by the 30 September. Further details on the award will be available in the near future.
