I	Title of decision: Acceptance of Youth Investment Fund Grant

4	Decision to be taken:
	I. To formally enter into the Onward Grant Agreement and accept the grant award from Youth Investment Fund of £3.463m (£2.790m Capital and £0.674m Revenue) under the Terms of the Onward Grant Agreement.
	The Grant provides funding for capital investment in built assets at strategic sites in the city – Derriford Community Park and Tinside – to enable increased provision of youth engagement activity in the natural spaces at these sites. It also provides funding for the grant period to invest in building the programme of activities for young people to engage with at these sites.
5	Reasons for decision:
	The decision is required to enable Plymouth City Council to accept the grant offer from the Youth Investment Fund to provide funding to progress capital and revenue activity to stimulate youth activity in partnership between Environmental Planning, Youth Services and Livewell South West at two sites – Derriford Community Park and Tinside – until March 2025.
	Separate Business Cases and Executive Decisions will deal with the allocation of the grant money against specific activity.
6	Alternative options considered and rejected:
	Do nothing, do not utilise, and therefore lose the Youth Investment Funding to progress delivery of the Joint Local Plan objectives.
