- Approve a revision to the approved decision that the Council's Shareholder Representative in matters related to the Chelson Community Solar Joint Venture company from Kim Brown (former Service Director for HROD) to the Council's Section 151 Officer, currently David Northey, Interim Service Director for Finance;
- 2. Delegate authority to the Section 151 Officer, (in consultation with the Project Board and Head of Legal Services) to approve the documentation and associated work to set up the joint venture, Chelson Community Solar, a private company limited by shares, between the Council and PEC Renewables Ltd, including but not limited to Articles of Association, the Shareholder Agreement, the Lease and Option Agreement, and variation of the existing landfill gas agreement relating to land at Chelson Meadow.

5 Reasons for decision:

- The revision has been proposed due to a change of staff, and to ensure continuation of the Council's shareholder representation.
- This revision will grant the Section 151 officer the authority to enter into all relevant documentation and agreements in relation to the joint venture vehicle.
- The revision will also grant the Section 151 officer the authority to exercise all voting rights on behalf of the Council as member of the company subject to Key Decisions (as defined by the Council's Constitution) being reserved to the Leader/ Cabinet, and take any necessary action to protect, safeguard and effectively manage the Council's interest in the Local Authority Trading Company.
