To implement the following amendments to The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004

The effect of the order shall be to:

I. Add/ Amend No Waiting At Any Time on lengths of the following road:

Hartley Avenue.

2. Add/Amend Limited Waiting on lengths of the following roads:

Lipson Road, Royal William Square.

3. Add/Amend Pay & Display on lengths of the following road:

Cliff Road.

4. Add Electric Vehicle Recharging Point At Any Time on lengths of the following roads:

Dingle Road, Hartley Avenue, Lipson Road, Madden Road, Royal William Square.

5. Add Car Club Vehicles only At Any Time on lengths of the following roads:

Hartley Avenue, Lipson Road, Royal William Square.

As set out in the briefing report

5 Reasons for decision:

All parking bays with electric vehicle charge points are required to be electric vehicle charging only bays. This means that the only cars that can park in these bays are electric vehicles that are charging. This solves the problem of car chargers being blocked by Internal Combustion Engine (ICE) cars and electric vehicles not charging.

Car club only bays will provide an electric car club vehicle with a guaranteed home space and car charger to return to at the end of its use.

Due to parking constraints and the changes that are planned for Plymouth Argyle ar Brickfields Sports Centre it has been decided to abandon the Madden Road propos revisit at a later date. It is recommended that all other proposals are implemen advertised.

6 Alternative options considered and rejected:

The alternative option would be to do nothing. This option was discounted on the basis that the changes are needed to ensure that EV drivers are not blocked by petrol and diesel cars when attempting to charge their cars and so that the car club vehicle always has a bay to return to.

7 Financial implications and risks:

The Traffic Regulation Orders (TRO's) and associated works are being funded by the mobility hubs budget.
