To implement the following amendments to The City of Plymouth (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2004 (Richmond Walk section)

The effect of the order shall be to:

I. Add/Amend Parking Restrictions on lengths of the following road:

Richmond Walk

As set out in the briefing report.

5 Reasons for decision:

- Richmond Walk Extend double yellow lines to increase visibility on the bend and to allow access for larger vehicles.
- Richmond Walk (near boat yard) Extend double yellow lines to allow access for boat yard and deliveries.

It is recommended that:

Richmond Walk restrictions are reduced to allow a section of parking.

6 Alternative options considered and rejected:

The alternative option would be to do nothing. This option was discounted on the basis that the changes are needed for safety improvements.
