Built in 1762, Plymouth's Orthodox Synagogue is the oldest Ashkenazi Synagogue still in regular use in the English speaking world! A visit to the Synagogue provides students with the opportunity to bring their classroom-based learning about the Jewish faith to life at a local level.

To ensure that you get the most from your visit, all sessions are led by a trained, knowledgeable & friendly speaker.

**Suitable for:** visits are suitable for KS1 – KS5 students & adults alike & are tailored according to age & individual needs

Length of visit: 1 and 2-hour visits are available (2-hour visits allow for more interactivity including role play & dressing up)

Number of children: up to a maximum of 60 students per visit

Requirements: schools are required to undertake their own risk assessment prior to their visit & are asked to ensure that their students are well prepared & dressed suitably
