	I. Add/Amend No Waiting At Any Time restriction on a length of the following road: Darklake View

5	Reasons for decision:								
	The proposal is to add double yellow lines in the turning head at the eastern end of Darklake View. The proposal is necessary as vehicles are currently parking in the turning area and causing obstruction. This means that large articulated lorries cannot turn and have had to turn on other private properties causing damage to the drive and barriers.								
	There is also an issue of damage to the grass verge and services surrounding the turning area.								
	The verge has been churned up and when it rains this causes the mud to block the drain next to								
	the turning area which has caused issues for residential properties beyond Darklake View.
