	On Elburton Road the proposal provides a new parallel pedestrian and cycle crossing, east of the junction with Colesdown Hill and Stentaway Road. This crossing would connect into the planned new section of the off-road walking and cycling path along the former railway line which is under development and is proposed to pass underneath Colesdown Hill and back onto Elburton Road. The crossing is intended to improve the route for walkers, cyclists, mobility scooters and parents with pushchairs.
