New process timetables for primary, junior, secondary and Keystage 4 schools at the normal point of entry. 5 Reasons for decision: The Council is under a statutory duty to consult upon and then determine the admission arrangements for all community and voluntary controlled schools where admission arrangements change, and to ensure that as far as possible, the admission arrangements for other categories of school meet the requirements of the School Admissions Code. The Council is also under a statutory duty to devise and agree upon a coordinated scheme of admissions in respect of the normal points of entry.
