	Do Nothing – allow the PDAS contract to end on March 31st 2025. We have a statutory duty to provide safe accommodation and this would lead to vulnerable adults and families with children who are survivors of domestic abuse having no support.							
	Award a direct contract for an extended period of 3-5 years. This would not make the required changes needed to ensure that the service meets the changing needs of the victims and survivors of domestic abuse into the future. In addition a longer contract could be challenged by other providers who have the capability and expertise to bid for the service contract.
