5	Reasons for decision:						
	<ol> <li>The project will provide additional Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) capacity creating 10 nursery assessment places and an additional 8-10 places within Woodlands School.</li> </ol>						
	<ol><li>The project will entail the fit-out of an unused space in the school following the closure of the Short Break provision on the site.</li></ol>						
6	Alternative options considered and rejected:						
	<b>Not proceed with project:</b> Rejected because this would not increase SEND capacity or facilitate the nursery assessment unit.						
	Create additional places at an alternative site: This would be a more costly option and would not be taking advantage of the currently available vacant space at Woodlands School.						
7	Financial implications and risk:						
	An addition of £728,392 to the capital programme, which is to be funded from the SEN / High Needs Grant.

	<ul> <li>Failure to complete the works by 2<sup>nd</sup> November (end of the half term holiday), meaning that SEND places will be limited for the 25/26 intake.
