## **Motion Narrative:**

## The Council Notes:

- Plymouth City Council is committed to delivering a more efficient and effective approach to highway maintenance.
- Plymouth will manage its transport assets to deliver a safe and well-maintained network
  that is fit for purpose whilst using resources wisely to deliver the best possible value for
  money.
- The contents of the Local Highways Maintenance Transparency Report outlines that the number of pot holes filled over the last 5 years has declined and the condition of Category A, B and C roads have also declined.

## **Action Required:**

The Council Therefore agrees to request the Cabinet Member for Strategic Planning and Transport to:

- I. Investigate the means of amending the Pothole Repair Policy, Highway Inspection Manual and Term Maintenance Contract to encourage the council's Highway Maintenance Contractors, when attending a highway defect, to proactively repair other defects in the vicinity.
- 2. Seek evidence to confirm the cost of this approach
- 3. Seek evidence to confirm whether this change of approach will improve the standard of the highway network.
