As requested by the Compton and Peverell Area Committee the following represents a breakdown of the planned investment in education facilities in the Compton and Peverell Area within the Financial Year 2010 /2011.

Compton

Sweat Peas Day Nursery Major refurbishment / remodel

Compton Primary School Major Project to provide an integrated nursery facility and

remove all temporary classrooms as well as extending the school to become a two form entry Primary School to meet the extending popular and successful Schools Programme.

Peverell

Hyde Park Post a significant Investment in FY 09 /10 to replace roof,

windows, doors and boiler system this school will receive a new kitchen facility to facilitate both the Infants and the

Juniors.

Montpelier The school will continue its remodel/ refurbishment to

facilitate the amalgamation of the Infants and the Juniors. The project is due to complete at the end of the Financial

Year.

Devonport High School for Girls Two small projects are currently ongoing at the school to

improve site security and access. Funding has been allocated to aid the school to develop a temporary building replacement programme which is planned to come to
