REVISED SCHEME OF DELEGATION FOR CABINET MEMBERS

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

All Cabinet Members shall -

- Individually and collectively, ensure the implementation of corporate priorities as agreed by Council.
- Provide strong and fair leadership and clear political guidance to councillors and officers.
- Provide community leadership and engagement through partnership working.
- Have a clear understanding of the portfolio, the scope and range of services for which they are responsible and council policies in respect of those services.
- Ensure the delivery of best practice and continuous improvement in services and implementation of best practice in the Council.
- Ensure an appropriate consultation programme is developed for their area of responsibility, to involve local people and communities in the decisions of the Council as fully as possible.
- Attend 100% of Cabinet meetings or, in exceptional circumstances, inform the Chair in advance if they are unable to attend and why.
- Respond within an agreed timescale to the recommendations of relevant scrutiny panel(s), setting out what action is proposed, if any, and giving full reasons for decisions taken.
- Meet with Chairs of relevant scrutiny panel(s) on a regular basis to discuss progress in their area of responsibility, responses to concerns raised by the scrutiny panel(s) and future programmes of work.
- Ensure that Cabinet members are briefed at the appropriate time on significant issues ie those that may:
 - Result in a change to established policy
 - Have major resource implications
 - o Be contentious or politically sensitive

THE LEADER

- Responsible for the appointment of Cabinet members, who together with the Leader make up the Cabinet;
- To act as Chair of Cabinet meetings and may act on behalf or instead of Cabinet members;
- To ensure that the policy framework and the budget of the Council is generally covered by the Cabinet member's responsibilities and that the Cabinet adheres to the framework in its decision making;
- To be ultimately and collectively responsible for all decisions made by Cabinet;
- Agrees the scheme of delegation to Cabinet and Cabinet members and can withdraw that delegation;
- At his/her ultimate discretion, to act on behalf of any other Cabinet members;

- In accordance with Article 6.4 of Part 1 of the Constitution, to appoint a Deputy Leader who may be required from time to time to assume at Cabinet the roles and responsibilities of the Leader and any other duties as allocated by the Leader.
