The report indicated that any such purchase would be subject to appropriate due diligence checks and would require Council approval. A more detailed report would be brought to Cabinet at the earliest opportunity.

Cabinet were advised that the report would be submitted to the next meeting of Cabinet on 18 October 2011 and the Leader suggested that an Extraordinary General Meeting of the City Council could be called following Cabinet, on 18 October 2011.
