5	Reasons for decision: To support the Council's agenda of increased and accelerated housing delivery and outputs required to provide more decent homes supporting citizens to live and work in Plymouth.									
	The Council aims to broaden the housing offer for the City by giving individuals the flexibility to design build housing for themselves and to increase the land supply for self-builders. The Council has established a register of self-build interest which currently has 85 households interested in self-build and demand is growing steadily.									
	The housing waiting list currently has over 10,000 households in need of affordable homes in Plymouth The Council has committed to providing 1,000 homes per annum for the next five years. In order to meet this target additional sites must be identified for housing development. Whilst genuine concerns have been raised over using these sites for self – build housing it is felt that the urgent need for broadening the housing offer outweighs these concerns.
