5. APPEAL CASES

8. Application for the grant of a private hire vehicle driver's licence - DF

10. Application for the grant of a private hire vehicle driver's licence -PJG

The committee heard that PJG was not in attendance and <u>agreed</u> that the matter would be adjourned until he confirmed that he wished the application to be dealt with.

11. Application for the grant of a private hire vehicle driver's licence - JH

The committee -

- (a) considered the report from the Director of Public Health;

The committee <u>agreed</u> to grant JH's application for a private hire vehicle driver's licence subject to him producing a DVLA Group 2 medical certificate and subject to him completing the VRQ in transporting passengers by taxi and private hire within the first 12 months of being licensed. JH will be excused from sitting both the Topographical Knowledge of Plymouth Test and the Driving Standards Test.

12. Review of a Hackney Carriage driver's licence - AL
