Independent Panel

Independent Panel is convened Officer and Disciplinary committee are represented. The Independent Panel review the decision and prepare a report to Council, giving clear reasons if they disagree with the recommendations of the Disciplinary Committee

Council

Council meets to consider the recommendation from the Disciplinary Committee and the report of the Independent Panel and consider the recommendation to dismiss. The Officer should be provided with a right of appeal against the decision and allowed to attend this meeting and address Council. The Independent Investigator may also be invited to attend to provide clarification if required. Following this consideration Council should either confirm or reject the recommendation to dismiss. It may at this stage impose a lesser sanction. This stage in the process constitutes the Officer's final right of appeal
