Proposed Funding Cuts to Schools within the City

Plymouth Schools already receive less funding per pupil than many other local authorities, including Devon. Funding cuts of an estimated £11.6 million by 2019 will exacerbate an already unfair situation, leading to a loss per pupil of £346, disadvantaging many of our children and young people.

The City Council agrees to write to the Secretary of State for Education to rectify this by taking urgent actions to end a school funding system that is unfair, outdated and opaque.
